Restrictions and Requirements

- Heritage Day is a family-oriented event — proper decorum is required of all participants.
- The committee has the authority to assign and/or change booth assignment positions.
- All vendors and participating organizations must have an assigned booth space.
- Vendors may only sell products or hand out literature in or immediately in front of their booth space.
- The committee is not responsible for injury or accident.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed to be sold or consumed within the area of Heritage Day activities
- All participants must provide their own set-ups and/or equipment.
- Set-up begins at 7 a.m. — tear down is at 5 p.m. If using a booth or canopy, these may not exceed the assigned area. NO equipment is provided by the Heritage Day Committee.
- All activities must be operational by 9:00 a.m.
- All food vendors must comply with the Greene County Health Department regulations and obtain the necessary certificates. For information and certificates, you may contact them at (937) 427-2883.
- Water is not available All cooking wastes (grease, bones, etc.) must be removed by the vendor.
- Payment for space must be **received** with application before may 30, 2010.
- There will be a \$10 late fee if not received by may 30, 2010.
- An additional \$10 late fee (\$20 total) will be charged if applications are received after June 11, 2010.
- No refunds will be given for cancellation of event due to inclement weather.
- Roadway must be cleared by 5:30 p.m. or subject to tow.
